









Programming (zoning)

Light Symphony allows programmable 'Areas' (zones) to be created, where each 'Area' can include any number of outputs from any number of lighting controllers. In this example, all of the front-garden lights have been programmed into 'Area 1' to create a user-friendly control, which includes output 1 on *both* lighting controllers. Area's 2-4 have been used to provide individual control of each circuit. The base-station wirelessly controls these 'Areas' too, using its dusk/dawn timers or iPhone app.
